Visit www.dmvNOW.com and explore more than 40 different transactions that can be conducted online. Renew your vehicle registration online, avoid the \$5 in-person fee and receive a \$1 discount. If eligible to renew your driver's license online, you'll receive a \$1 discount. Change your address, sign up for electronic renewal notifications via email or text, buy a personalized plate and more.

MAIL

Mail your vehicle registration renewals to avoid a \$5 fee for in-person service. Driver's license renewals can also be mailed.

DMV Select

Forty-nine DMV Selects offices throughout Virginia provide you with a convenient alternative to a full-service DMV customer service center. The \$5 fee for in-person vehicle registration renewals does not apply at DMV Selects. Visit www.dmvNOW.com for locations.
