

Vehicle Registration/IRP Update

With the continuous efforts to open the DMV Customer Service Centers (CSCs), the following new procedures will be used for apportioned registration--both new and renewal.

Effective July 6, payment or credential pick up at a DMV CSC is no longer an option. If you have recently processed credentials and elected to pick the credential up at a CSC but have not yet done so, call the Motor Carrier Work Center at (804) 249-5140 to have the credentials mailed or emailed. March, April, May, June and July vehicle expirations, have been granted an extension. March 2020 are now extended through September 30, 2020 and registrations expiring in April, May, June and July 2020 are extended through October 31, 2020.

If you buy a new truck, the dealer can take care of the titling work, but they are unable process apportioned registration.

When you register a vehicle for interstate operation, you may obtain a 30-day temporary registration; however, you will need to check with each jurisdiction in which you want to operate that vehicle to determine if they allow interstate travel on a 30-day temporary plate.

Upon the expiration of the temporary plate, you will need to register the vehicle under the International Registration Plan (IRP) and obtain an apportioned plate and cab card. If you have an already established IRP account this may be accomplished via VirginiaMCS. If an account needs to be created or you do not wish to use VirginiaMCS, submit a paper application (IRP 1 found on DMV's website, www.dmvnow.com) via fax to (804) 367-1073 or email to iftairp@dmv.virginia.gov.

- VirginiaMCS transactions must be paid via VirginiaMCS and you may choose one of the following delivery options:
 - Standard Mail or
 - Expedited Special Mail (UPS or FedEx, at your expense)
- Paper applications processed will produce an invoice and those invoices may be paid by mail or by calling the Motor Carrier team at 804-249-5140. DMV will mail the credentials (plate and cab card (registration)) to you; ensure to let the Motor Carrier representative know if you would like expedited special delivery (UPS or FedEx, at your expense).

To obtain an International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) license and decal:

1. If you have an already established IFTA account this may be accomplished via VirginiaMCS. If an account needs to be created or you do not wish to use VirginiaMCS, submit a paper application (RDT 120 found on DMV's website,

www.dmvnow.com) via fax to (804) 367-1073 or email to iftairp@dmv.virginia.gov.

- VirginiaMCS transactions must be paid via VirginiaMCS and you may choose one of the following delivery options:
 - Standard Mail or
 - Expedited Special Mail (UPS or FedEx, at your expense)

- Paper applications processed will produce an invoice and those invoices may be paid by mail or by calling the Motor Carrier team at 804-249-5140.
