



RESIDENCY CERTIFICATION

You must be a Virginia resident to obtain a Virginia driver's license, commercial driver's license, temporary driver's license, instruction permit, or DMV photo identification card. If you do not have documents that are acceptable to prove you are a Virginia resident, you may submit this completed certification as part of your application to prove that you live in Virginia.

It is illegal for anyone to give a false or fictitious address in an application for a driver's license or identification card. Since this certification is considered to be part of the application, anyone found guilty of certifying to a false or fictitious address herein shall be guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor, or if it is shown that the license or identification card is intended to be used to purchase a firearm, shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony.
