

Important Notice for For-Hire Vehicle Operators

Vehicle Registration Form Change

Effective November 25, 2010, DMV is implementing a new vehicle registration application form designed specifically for vehicles operated for-hire.

For-Hire Vehicles Vehicle Registration Application (VSA 123) asks applicants for detailed information about their for-hire operations such as:

- ▶ lessee information (to be completed by the lessee if the vehicle being registered is owned by or being registered in a name other than the holder of the intrastate operating authority certificate or permit)
- ▶ certification of the level of insurance maintained
- ▶ certification from the insurance company for the holder of the operating authority certificate or permit (required for leased operations only)
- ▶ seating capacity of the vehicle
- ▶ type of exemption operation, if applicable

The new form should be used for all for-hire vehicle registration applications, including requests for an original registration, reissue of plates or decals or transfer of plates. Vehicle registration renewal notices will continue to be provided and may be used for registration renewals. If the renewal notice is not available, the VSA 123 should be used.

The new requirements applicable to leased operations (as stated above) apply to applications for an original registration or the transfer of an existing registration to another vehicle and must be completed before the application will be processed.
