

Driver's Licenses and ID Cards

Your new driver's license or identification card will be mailed to you. For security, DMV has discontinued issuing licenses over the counter.

Driver's license applicants will be given temporary driving permits that cannot be used for identification purposes. ID card applicants will be given a receipt.

Customers renewing Virginia driver's licenses or ID cards can keep your old license or ID card to carry with the temporary driving permit or receipt, until you receive your new license or ID card in the mail within two weeks.

If you have moved without notifying DMV, you will not receive your new card. Make sure your address is correct on your DMV record.



There is a critical shortage of organ and tissue donors in the Commonwealth. This means each week, several Virginians die waiting for a life-saving organ transplant. This could be your friend, your neighbor, or your family member. You can help save or improve the quality of life for up to 50 people through organ, tissue and eye donation.

Questions and answers

- ▶ ***How do I become an organ donor?***
Check the appropriate box on the DMV driver's license or ID card application or renewal. Your choice will be noted on the front of your driver's license or photo ID card.
- ▶ ***What if I change my mind?***
Contact Donate Life Virginia to have your name removed from the organ donor registry.

- ▶ ***How do I change the status on my driver's license or ID card?*** Apply for a replacement driver's license or ID card. You can complete this transaction online or make the change as part of your next driver's license or ID card renewal.
- ▶ ***Will the decision to become a donor affect the quality of my medical care?*** No. Organ and tissue donation happens only after every effort has been made to save your life and death has been legally declared.
- ▶ ***Are there any age considerations for donation?*** Anyone of any age can register to become a donor. However, consent from a parent or legal guardian is necessary to proceed with donation from a minor.

- ▶ ***Are there any costs to be a donor?***
No. There is no cost to the donor's family or estate.
